



Becoming Curious 4: A Question of Identity

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. This weekend was Mother's Day. Tell your favorite story about a mom—whether it was your own mom or someone else.
2. Casey started the talk by asking a question—"Who do you think you are?" Talk about how you would answer this question, and if that answer changed as a result of this weekend's message.
3. The message this weekend was based on Matthew 16:13-17. Read through that passage together—talk about what words, phrases, or ideas stand out to you from this weekend's passage.
4. Casey talked about four ways of finding our identity: through *conforming* (identity as what other people expect), *comparing* (identity determined by what other people are doing), *combating* (identity from who you're NOT going to be), and finally through *connecting* (identity by connecting with who God designed you to be). Talk about your own identity and which of the four ways you recognize as a way you've tried to find your identity.
5. One of the hardest questions from this weekend's message was this: *What if we show our identity through what we give our lives to?* Talk about what you're giving your life (your time, energy, priorities, and action) to and how that reflects who you really are.
