You may have questions about what we're doing to ensure Launch is clean and safe for your family. What we are committed to do as Launch Kids at Heartland.

- Volunteers follow hand-washing procedures and children are instructed to wash their hands after using the bathroom and before eating.
- Volunteers follow posted safe and sanitary diaper-changing procedures.
- Volunteers and children use hand sanitizer in all classrooms. Hand wipes are used for children 2 and under
- Volunteers disinfect the room in addition to wiping down surfaces (including toys) after each service.
- Staff remove children from the classroom when they appear to be sick, and parents are paged to pick them up.

What we ask of you as a parent. Please do not bring your child to church if they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (must be fever-free for 24 Hours)
- Vomiting or diarrhea (must be symptom-free for 24 hours)
- Common cold from onset through one week
- Respiratory infection
- Flu
- Sore throat or strep throat
- Croup
- Cloudy or green runny nose
- Infectious or unexplained rash
- Pinkeye or other eye infection (must be on medication a minimum of 24 hours)
- Any childhood disease (e.g., scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chickenpox)
