## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1.	Are your own neighbors the kind of folks you'd invite over for dinner? Do you see each other in passing without really knowing them? What's the relationship like?
2.	Read Luke 10:25-28. What can we learn about Jesus from the way he responds to the "expert" of the law?
3.	Continue reading in Luke 10, verses 29-37. How do you interpret the actions of the three peop who encounter the dying man on the road to Jericho?
4.	Have you ever experienced the sacrificial care and love that the Samaritan shows here—someone who pushed pause on their own agenda to help you? Who was it and what did they do for you?
5.	Jesus' instruction to the expert of "Go and do likewise" doesn't leave much room for

interpretation. How would you answer Trevor's question from his teaching—who can you be a

neighbor to? Who can I give freely to without expecting anything in return?
